

## TR filing Due Date for FY 2019-20 Extended Further



The Government has given a big relief to the taxpayers once again!

The deadline for the **income tax return filing** for FY 2019-20, i.e. AY 2020-21 for many individual taxpayers has now been further extended from the present due date of 31st December 2020, to 10<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

However, the ITR filing due date has been for only those individual tax assessees who are not subject to Income tax audit u/s 44AB of Income Tax Act 1961. These are the normal taxpayers who file their income tax returns through Forms ITR-1 (Sahaj) or ITR-4 (Sugam), as applicable.

Let us go through this update in detail.

## **Income Tax Return Filing Due-Date Extended for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time**

Keeping view of the major setback faced by Indian business due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, and the resultant incapability of the taxpayers to meet their statutory compliances, the Government had passed the Taxation & Other Laws (Relaxation of Certain Provisions) Ordinance, 2020 on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020. This ordinance, inter alia, sought for extension of various deadlines.

- Under the said Ordinance, the Government had issued a Notification on 24<sup>th</sup> of June 2020 that extended the due date for filing of all Income Tax Returns for the FY 2019-20 (i.e. AY 2020-21) to **30<sup>th</sup> November**, **2020**. As a result, the due date of Income tax returns that were supposed to be filed latest by 31<sup>st</sup> July 2020 and 31<sup>st</sup> October 2020 was extended to 30<sup>th</sup> November 2020. Besides, the due date for filing tax audit reports under the Income Tax Act 1961 was extended to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2020.
- In order to provide some more time to the taxpayers for Income Tax Return filing, the ITR filing due date has been further extended as follows
  - i. Due date for Income Tax Return filing for the taxpayers who are subject tax audit, and for whom the due date was earlier 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2020, was postponed to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2020.
  - ii. Due date for ITR Filing for the taxpayers who are required to file report with regard to international/specified domestic transactions, was extended from 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2021.
  - iii. Due date for ITR Filing for all other taxpayers was extended 31<sup>st</sup> July 2020 to **31<sup>st</sup> December, 2020.**
  - iv. Accordingly, the deadline for various Audit Reports (incl. tax audit report and report of international/specified domestic transaction was extended to 31st December 2020.

However, noticing the serious challenges being faced by the taxpayers, the Government has extended the FY 2019-20 ITR filing due date for a **third time**.

## **New Income Tax Return Filing Due-Dates**

The new Income Tax Return Filing Due-Dates are given as below –

- i. Due date for Income Tax Return filing for the taxpayers who are subject tax audit: <u>15<sup>th</sup></u> <u>February 2021.</u>
- ii. Due date for ITR Filing for the taxpayers who are required to file report with regard to international/specified domestic transactions: **15**<sup>th</sup> **February 2021**.
- iii. Due date for ITR Filing for all other taxpayers: 10<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

- iv. The deadline for various Audit Reports (incl. tax audit report and report of international/specified domestic transactions: **15**<sup>th</sup> **February 2021**.
- v. Besides, deadline for filing declaration under <u>Vivad Se Vishwas Scheme</u> has been extended to <u>31<sup>st</sup> January 2021</u>
- vi. Due date for passing orders under *Vivad Se Vishwas* Scheme, has been extended to <u>31st</u> <u>January</u>, 2021.
- vii. Deadline for passing the order or the issuance of notice by the authorities under Direct Taxes & Benami Acts that were earlier required to be passed/ issued latest by 30<sup>th</sup> March 2021 is now extended to <u>31<sup>st</sup> March 2021</u>.

These are the new due dates for the Income tax compliance.
