Filing of Non-Preferential CoO via a common platform is allowed until August 1:DGFT

The Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) has issued a notification regarding the extension of compulsory electronic filing of Non-Preferential Certificate of origin (CoO) via the common digital platform to August 1, 2022.

This step will now permit exporters and NP CoO issuing agencies to use the current systems of processing non-preferential CoO applications through manual or paper mode for the following three months.

Exporters and NP CoO issuing agencies will still be able to use the notice's online system.

DGFT has cautioned about severe penal action and delisting against entities who won't use the online system for the issue of non-preferential CoOs post-August 1, 2022.

DGFT has also asked the agencies to make the exporting community aware of their constituents about the online system and its registration in time and has directed the users to report issues related to the new system and its implementation.
