



**The DGFT Issues Notification in regard to  
Revision of Permission for Importing of PET  
Flake**

On 14th September 2022, the Directorate General of Foreign Trade issued a notification regarding the revision of the Import Policy of PET Flake. This notification was issued by the Central Government subject to the exercise of powers as conferred in Section 3 to be read with Section 5 of the Foreign Trade (Development and Regulation) Act, 1992, to be read with Para 1.02 and 2.01 of the Foreign Trade Policy (FTP). The Central Government made amendments to the Import Policy, revising Condition No. 2 of Chapter 39 of the ITC (HS), 2022, Schedule I (Import Policy)

The import of PET Flake is now permitted in India subject to the following conditions -

- DGFT Authorization
- NOC from MoEF & CC
- The unit has completed one year after commencing production
- The unit has used domestic waste to the extent of 70% of the capacity in the previous year
- Import is 15% of the actual capacity

However, the importing of PET Bottles is still prohibited in India.
